

THESIS PROJECTS

The purpose of the Thesis is to allow the student to pursue an independent line of study for an extended period in considerable depth, bringing together various skills from studio and classroom which have been acquired over the previous years. The Thesis is also a comprehensive summary of what has been learned to date, so technical competence must be exhibited in all aspects of a Thesis project. Thesis projects will not only be judged on the quality of work presented, but also on the processes used to produce it.

GUIDELINES for doing PROJECTS:

Students are advised to carefully read the instructions given and follow them in the preparation of the project report. Non-compliance with any of these instructions may lead to the rejection of project report submitted.

- The duration of project work will be for 6 months.
- The project guide: the qualification of the project guide is PG. A guide should work as faculty in the college/university. He/she should handle class for UG in Bachelor of Science in (Fashion Design / Interior Design).
- Students are expected to undertake project work individually and submit an individual project report.
- Project report should be typed / printed in double line space using A4 size bond papers with a left margin of column 10 & right margin of column 65.
- A page should not contain more than 25 lines.
- All pages should be numbered. The preliminary pages of the project report (such as title page, acknowledgement, table of contents, etc.) should be numbered in lower case Roman numbers and pages of the main text starting with chapter 1 should be consecutively numbered in Arabic numbers.
- Binding specifications: wrapper should be light blue in color and printing of wrappers should be done in the press and hard bound
- Table of contents should be as in the specified format.
- Everyone should use the emblem of Madras Institute of Fashion Technology and University in the project report.
- A certificate from the organization where you undertake the project work should be obtained and copies of the same should be duly enclosed in the project report.



REVIEW

The students are requested to report to the guide concerned of the project review by your guide twice during project work.

The students are expected to make a power point presentation on their project – objectives, work carried out so far, design, development, output, expected, status, plan of the remaining period. Attendance for the project review is compulsory.

- Format of the report is as follows:
- 1. Wrapper
- 2. Copy of the wrapper
- 3. Declaration by the candidate
- 4. Certificate from the guide
- 5. Certificate from the organization
- 6. Acknowledgement
- 7. Synopsis
- 8. Tables of contents
- 9. Chapters
- 10. Bibliography (in the alphabetical order of authors)

The students must write to the head of the institution, with a copy of the letter from the Guide, the date of commencement of the project, the name of the organization, the name of the guide from industry and the likely topic of the project.

• FINAL SUBMISSION:

Three copies of the project report should be submitted positively on or before the specified date to the head of the institution.
